Captain Jamal is the Overall Champion of Round 2

The second round of 'The 2017 Angler of the Year PDO Recreation Club' competition was held on Saturday 20th May 2017. This competition was generously sponsored by Seven Seas Petroleum Oman represented by Mr. Sandeep who attended the prize giving ceremony and distributed prizes to the winners.

At dawn the RAH boat centre was buzzing with activities, the eager fishermen arrived with full vigor after a previous week cancelled event as a result of anticipated bad weather. The boats were launched smoothly and the new winch cable performed perfectly.

The competition started at 0600hrs due to onset of summer and boats were expected back at the bay by competition closing time at 1330hrs. A total of eight fishing boats were sea born with a total of 16 keen fishermen. The engines rumbled in the sea with anxious fishermen ready to start the sea hunt!

The event started with anglers speeding to different secret locations hoping to catch the heaviest bottom and game fishing categories. No one was seen at deeper depths of 140 to 200 meters deep. It appeared every one stayed in and around 85 to 120 meters reefs. Never the less the captain and his partner ventured towards weather buoy for Mahi Mahi but sadly without any luck. The sea condition was reasonably good but strong current and hot summer temperatures made it tough day fishing. The

main catch was few groupers, Andaq, red snappers, small Mahi Mahi and bonitos. There were large number of baby sharks being caught but these are never counted in the competition and are released back in the sea.

One boat developed engine problem and had to return back by 1030hrs. This was very unfortunate as the team already had a very promising game catch of over 10 kg. Due to tough conditions couple of boats was seen heading back to the bay by around 12pm well ahead of the competition end time of 1330hrs. One team was disqualified by using motorized reel. This was a tough decision for the captain to make as the team was apparently not aware of the competition rules that are in place.

After the event at 1330 hours the anglers returned with a number of different fish species including the famous groupers with sizes ranging from 1 to 2 kg, red snappers and Andaq caught mainly at 85 meters reef, bonito, and a nice size Mahi Mahi.

The day proves to be a tough fishing day and that is reflected in the lower overall catch of 53.2kg. The team of Raju Mathew and Lixin Wang has the largest bottom catch of 13.1 kg that secures them 1st and 2nd place in bottom category while Salim Khatri and Faisal Riyami managed to catch 10.7kg of game fishing and a 1st and 2nd place in game category. The overall joint winner of the day was Captain Jamal Balushi with 14 points followed by Mundhir Riyami who also got 14 points but was piped by Captain Jamal on bottom category. The catch of the day was 2.85kg cockpit caught by Mundhir Riyami.




Biggest catch 2.85kg Cockpit - Mundhir Riyami

- 2. Salim Khatri and Raju Mathew the winners of 1st game and 1st bottom fishing categories respectively
- 3. Faisal Riyami and Lixin Wang the runners up on game and bottom fishing categories.
- 4. Mundhir Al Riyami with the prize of the a biggest fish of the day a cockpit of 2.85kg

Congratulations to the winners, runners up and the anglers on the successful 2nd round fishing event. The angler of the year trophy is still open; the next fishing competition is planned in Sept after the summer break.



Day Trip Central Daymaniyat Islands (Friday 28th April 2017)

On 28th April a group of 5 paddlers met at Manumah Beach for the 10mile /16km crossing to the Central Daymaniyat Islands.

With certain safety precautions in place, including the presence of 2 support boats for most of the trip, the group set off at 08:30, heading for the horizon, guided by a northerly compass heading. A modest NW breeze in the early morning kept the paddlers relatively cool although the associated waves required some effort and skill to negotiate. About half-way the support vessels caught up and then charged ahead to the islands which were slowing coming into view. After nearly 3 hours



the group arrived at a picture-perfect beach, greeted by the 9 crew on both vessels.



KAYAK SECTION

The islands themselves have a certain Robinson Crusoe feeling to them, apart from a near-total lack of vegetation, some mangroves aside. The near-shore reefs and extreme clarity of the waters make this one of the world's premier dive spots (or perhaps due to the warm waters too?). We exchanged the kayaks for a place on-board and the whole group enjoyed a tour around the islands, dropping



anchor at a few places (carefully on sandy spots to avoid damaging the beautiful corals) for superb snorkelling and swimming.

With NE wind on the return leg, the return journey was completed in a little over 2 hours, again part-shepherded by the support vessels. A nice team dinner at the club completed an excellent day, worthy of a repeat later in the year!

NOTE: an open water crossing by kayak requires extensive preparation and sea kayaking experience and should not be attempted by unprepared and inexperienced individuals.

The Daymaniyat Island nature reserve is closed from May till October.

After Work Paddle - Thursday Evening

If you wish to increase your paddling confidence, regular Thursday late afternoon paddles depart from the club beach. Meet at the kayak storage area. The departure time varies throughout the year according to sunset time. Contact Kayak Section for weekly e-mail notice and further information.

Club Kayaks

Five sit-on-top kayaks are available for general use. Two are double seaters and three are single seaters. They may be borrowed by club members who follow these rules.

B - Club Equipment

- (1) Club equipment (kayaks, paddles and/or buoyancy aids) are stored near the CSP (Club Safety Post) and must be signed-out in the CSP, leaving membership club card with the CSP personnel. Parents must sign on behalf of their children.
- (2) <u>Club kayaks must NOT be taken outside RAHRC bay</u> and must always be in sight of the CSP unless participating in organised events/activities.
- (3) A single kayak must only be paddled by a one kayaker and a double kayak must only be paddled by two kayakers.
- (4) Club equipment may only be borrowed when the CSP is open and must be returned before CSP is closed.
- (5) Guests may not borrow club kayaks unless accompanied on the water by a club member who shall be responsible for the safe return of the equipment.
- (6) Kayaks must be lifted or moved with trolley and not dragged on the ground/beach.
- (7) All equipment must be washed thoroughly with freshwater after use.
- (8) Equipment damage must be reported to the CSP personnel.
- (9) Kayaks should be returned to the club kayak rack near the CSP.


Annual Badminton Tournament 2017 the last event of this year (2016-17) was held on 05 & 06-May-2017 under the following categories:


Round The Island Dive




Boat News

Not only do the boats have new seats but we finally have a GPS/Side Scan Sonar unit fitted to AW to replace the old unit which was damaged beyond repair in mysterious circumstances late last year.

Thanks to Jamie for his hard work in getting this sorted out.

In line with the club safety policy, both dive boats now have VHF radios fitted – while these are "line of sight" and hence unable to call the Club from the far side of the island the amount of large ship traffic in the area that monitors the main channels means any real emergency is likely to be supported quickly and messages passed on. The radios were fitted in time for the Fahal Swim and proved invalauble in coordinating activities.


