### Contribution for November Bulletin





The fourth round of 'The 2017 Angler of the Year PDO Recreation Club' competition was held on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> Nov 2017 at Ras Al Hamra. This competition was generously sponsored by Yokogawa and was represented by Mr. Khalid Saleh, Senior Vice President, Corporate HRD, Administration and QHSE who presented the prizes. He was accompanied by Mr. Ebrahim Obaid, Assistant General Manager who is also an accomplished Arabic calligrapher. He prepared on the spot certificates with Arabic calligraphy which he presented to all the winners. This unique and unexpected gesture was greatly appreciated by all the participants.

Following the previous round in august where a huge total catch of 153 kilos, all competitors were keen and eager to get back into action. After all there was angler of the year title was still up for grab with close overall results after the third round. A total of seven teams participated which was one less than the last round. The sea conditions were not ideal with wind and moderate waves even though the temperature was a perfect 30 degrees

By 6:10am a number of boats were already in the water with their engines rumbling and eager to start the sea hunt and waiting for competition to commence at 6:30. A week before captain Jamal caught an impressive catch of Hamoor, Cockpit, Bonitos, Small Tunas and Mahi Mahi and anticipation of good day fishing was running her among the participants. As usual the team at the boat centre performed an amazing job and ensured all boats were launched safely without any incident. Anglers were eager help each other to retrieve the trailers after launch with usual sense of humor and loudest laughs.

Before the competition ends time of 1230hrs boats could be seen heading back to Fahal bay with their The day prove to be tough with only 30kg of bottom fishing and 74kg of game fishing. The total catch was 104kg and was one of the lowest this season. The biggest catch of the day was 5.25 Mahi Mahi caught by Dr. Hakeem.






