It has been a privilege to serve as Honorary Treasurer here at RAHRC for just over two years now, in what turned out to be a pivotal time in terms of funding and capital investment. Further changes are on the horizon, some you would have already experienced as the Club partners with third parties to enhance service offerings. Stakeholders are incentivized to see these pilots succeed, and these efforts will soon supported by a booking and payment infrastructure facilitate member to further convenience and timely Club reporting.

"Get Golf Ready" is on-going until the end of May, and you can look forward to the Club's Eid Al Fitr Party in June Insha'Allah. Thank you to all the volunteers who make these possible.

With the now enhanced collaboration with RAHGC, your next departmental "Away Day" can start at the driving range or a round of "foot golf" before moving to the Clubhouse for lunch or one of our meeting rooms to share key department messages, followed by a sightseeing boat tour with your teams.
